<b>Who's eligible?</b>	Minimum <b>2.5 GPA</b> for academic coursework Minimum <b>2.0 GPA</b> for technical/vocational coursework Must be enrolled at least part-time at high school  Parent permission Counselor permission	Minimum <b>2.5 GPA</b> for academic coursework Minimum <b>2.0 GPA</b> for technical/vocational coursework  Parent permission Counselor permission if during school day
<b>Which courses?</b>	Any course 101 and above (Exclude PENP and Advanced Placement)	Any course
<b>Student Expenses</b>	Course specific fees Transportation	Tuition and fees Course specific fees Required books Transportation
<b>Student Responsibility</b>	Report enrollment changes to the college registrar and high school counselor  Drop with college registrar before refund date if not attending  <b>Return books to school district</b>	Drop class before refund date if not attending
