Spring 2011 Enrollment Analysis

A typical UNMLA student this semester is 19-year old female of Hispanic or dual ethnic origin, who is enrolled on a part-time basis.

Our Spring 2011 headcount (HC) of 915 shows an increase of 8% in total enrollment since Spring 2010 when our HC was 847. Our SCH and FTE have both increased by 13% from last year. These increases are primarily due to a 14% increase in Returning students, a 9% increase in Readmitted and an increase in Concurrent students - a total of 238, which is 8% above Spring 2010 and 303% more than in 2007. Our two categories to experience a drop were New Freshmen (down 33% from last Spring and Transfer students (down 12% from last Spring).

Our enrollment by student level shows that this semester we had a 17% increase in the number of Undergrad students, a 9% decrease in Non-degree students and an 8% increase in Concurrent students. The surge in Concurrent enrollment had a dramatic impact on our Undergrad to Concurrent to Non-Degree ratio. If in the past (2001 through 2008) the ratio was 75% undergraduate degree seeking: 5% concurrent: 25% non-degree; this semester the ratio is 52% undergraduate degree seeking, 22% concurrent 26% non-degree.

When it comes to Spring 2010 cohort demographics, 52% of our student body are minorities, up from 50% last year.

- Our African American student enrollment is down 33% since last year and up 100% from Spring 2007.
- Our American Indian enrollment is at an all-time high of 75, up 19% over last year.
- Our Asian student population is 24% below last year's.
- Our Hispanic students make up 40% of our student body, which is higher than 38% we had in Spring 2010 and is within the normal 40-38% range we have had since 2003.

Our Full-time enrollment is up 2% from Spring 2010 and down 3% from Spring 2007. However, our average load per student has increased 5% from 6.22 credits in Spring 2010 to 6.49 credits this semester. Part-time enrollment is up 5% from last year and up 24% from Spring 2007.

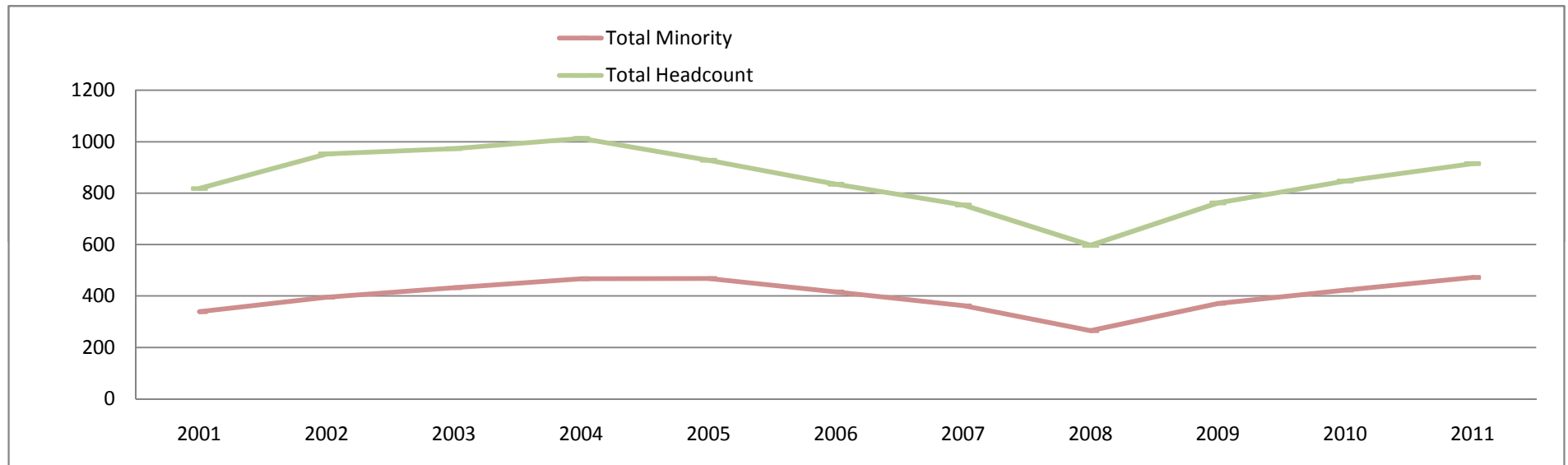
At our Bernalillo Townsite total HC is down 14% from Spring 2010, but still up 12% from Spring 2007. Our Bernalillo Site provides 53% of our total American Indian enrollment, 10% of our Black student enrollment and 26% of our total Hispanic student enrollment this semester. Overall 84% of our Bernalillo Site students are minorities. Full-time enrollment is down 15% from Spring 2010, but up 1767% Spring 2010; part-time enrollment is down 13% from last year and down 24% from Spring 2007. Overall, although our Bernalillo Townsite student body is smaller, it is more diverse than it was in Spring 2010.

With the projected increase of Concurrent students State-wide, we hope to continue improving our enrollment numbers in the future semesters.

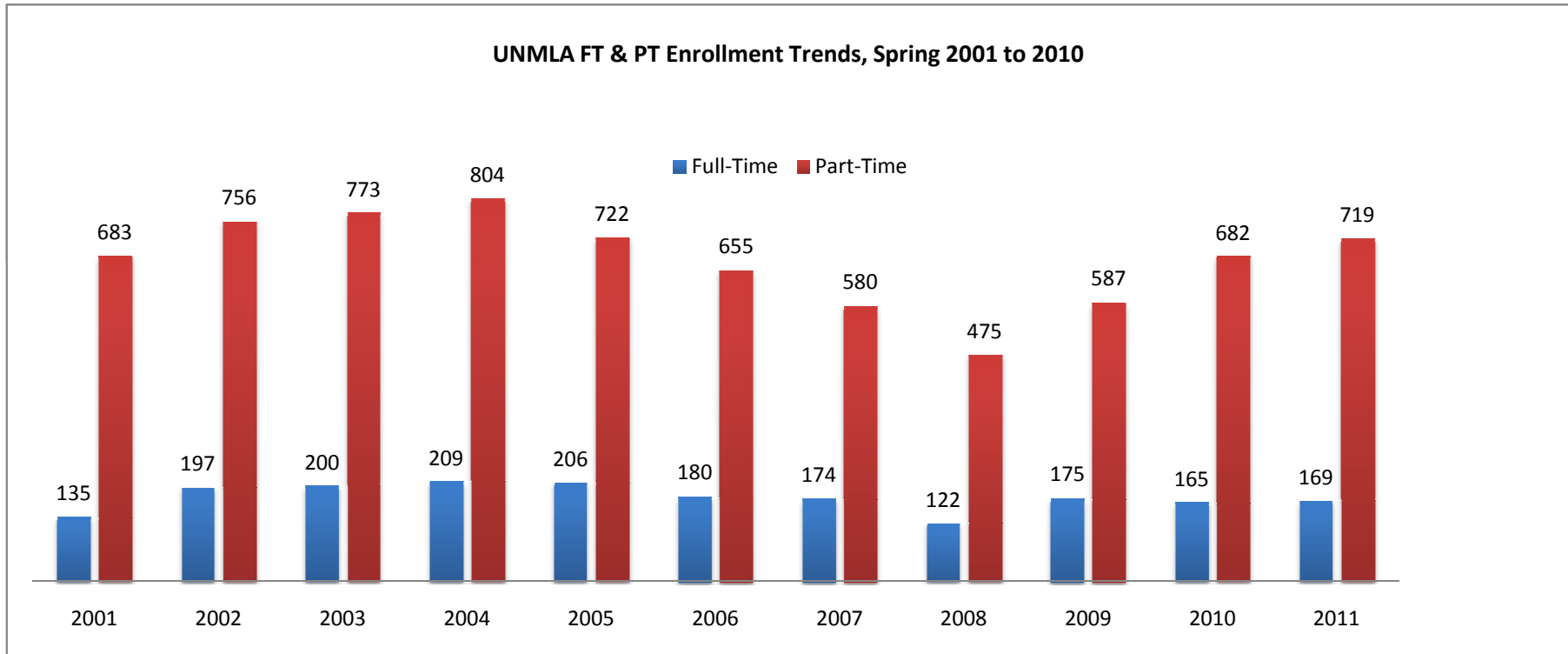

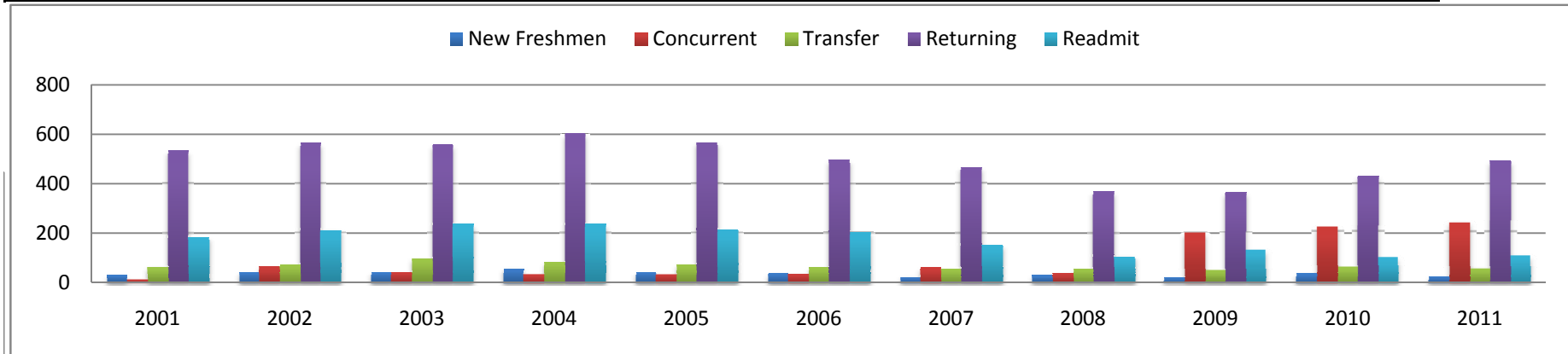
UNMLA FT & PT Enrollment Trends, Spring 2001 to 2010

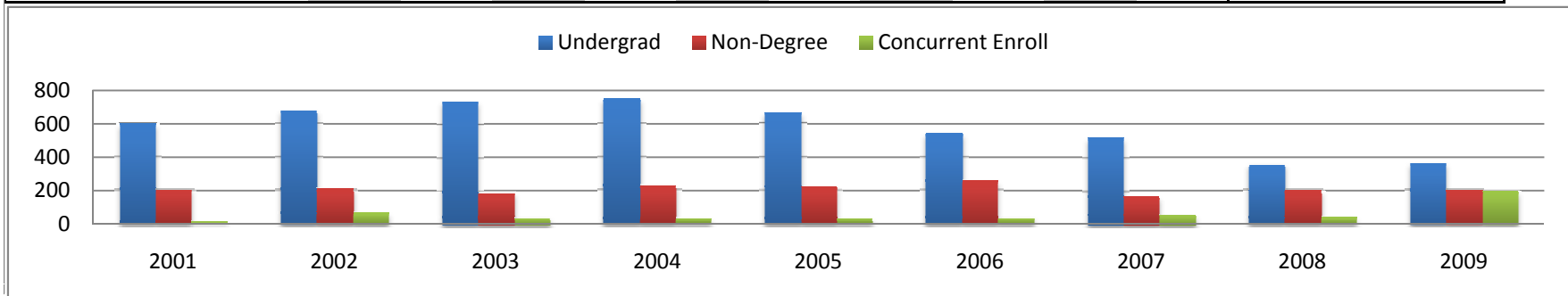

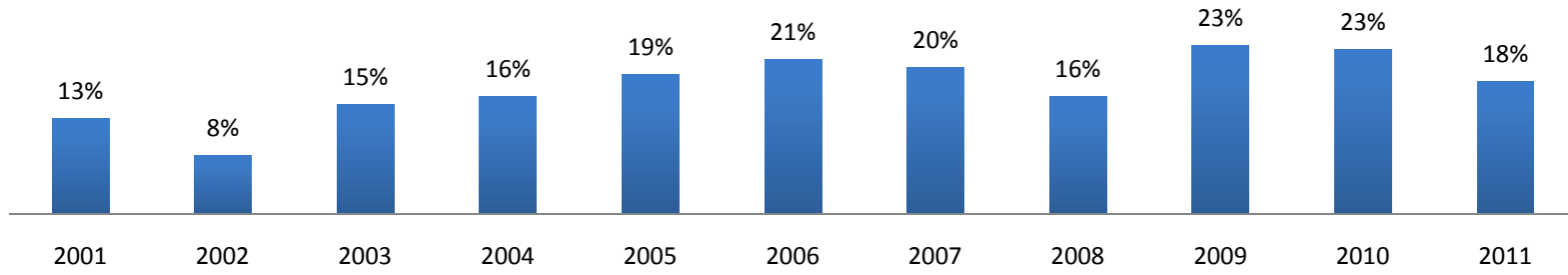

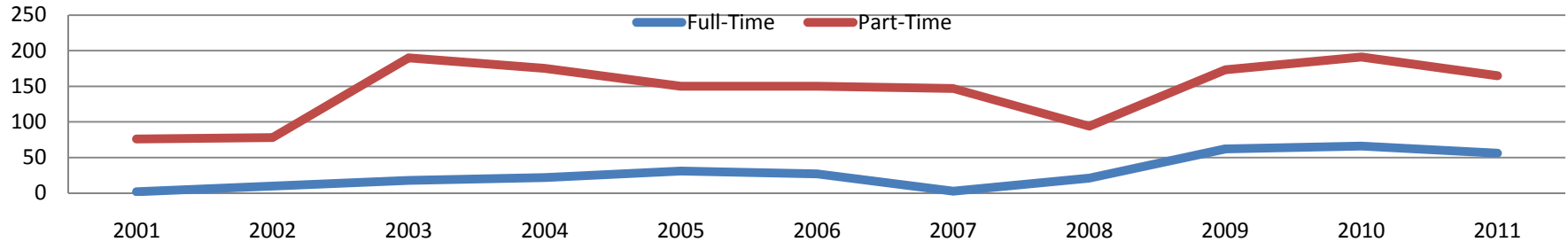
