

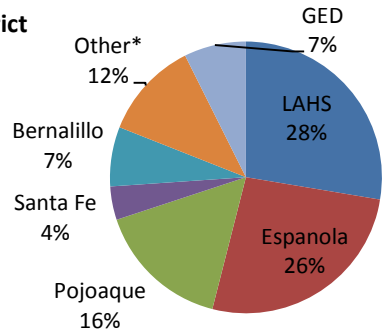

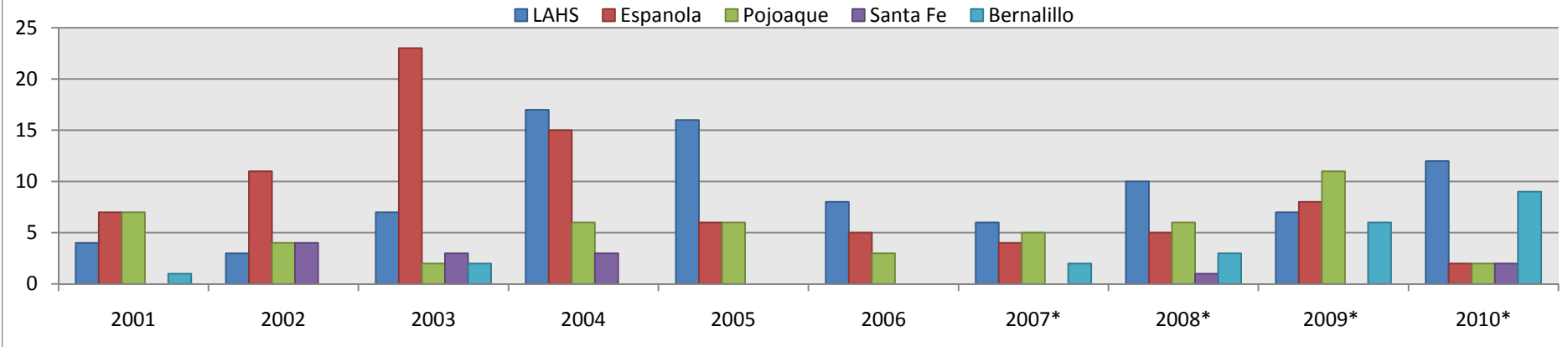
#### Program Enrollment by School District

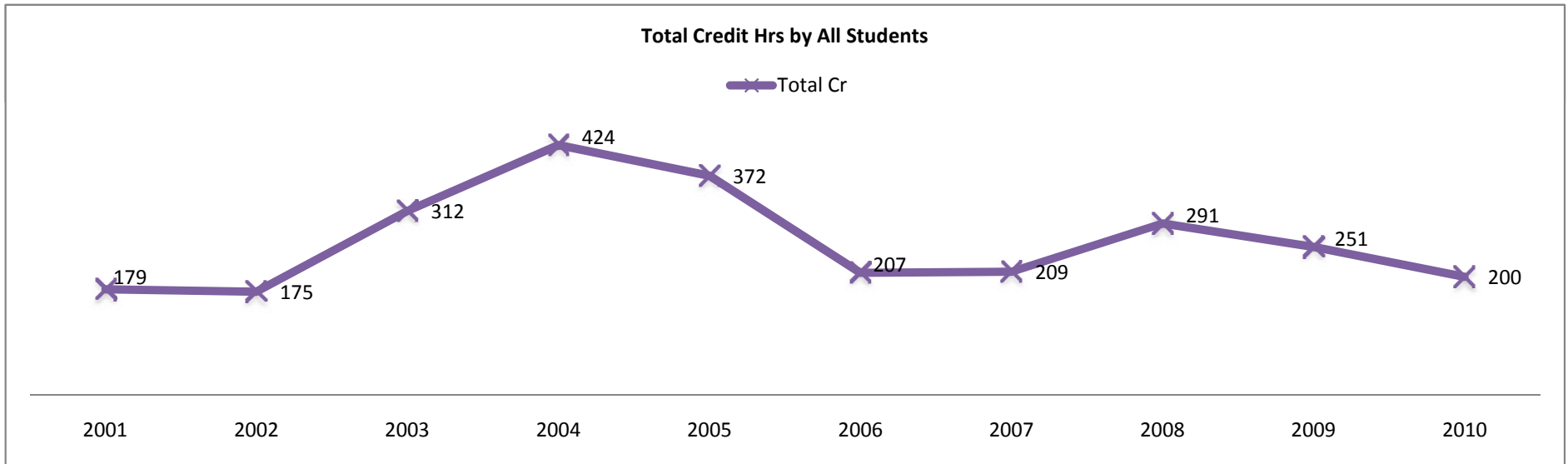
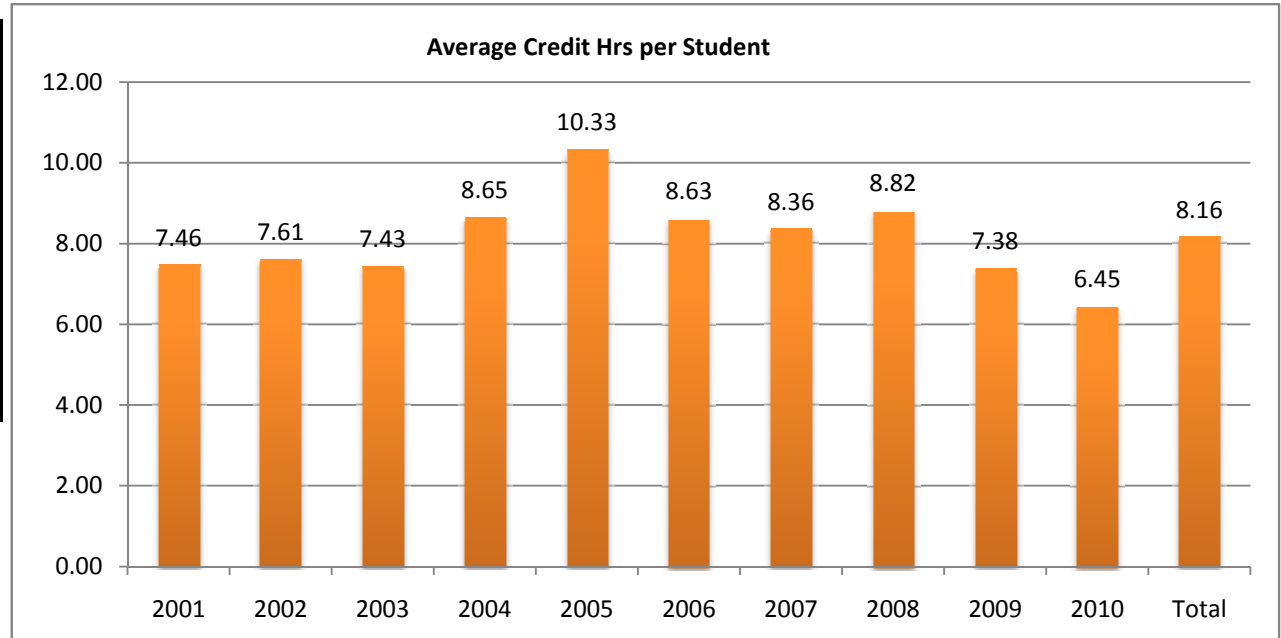
