

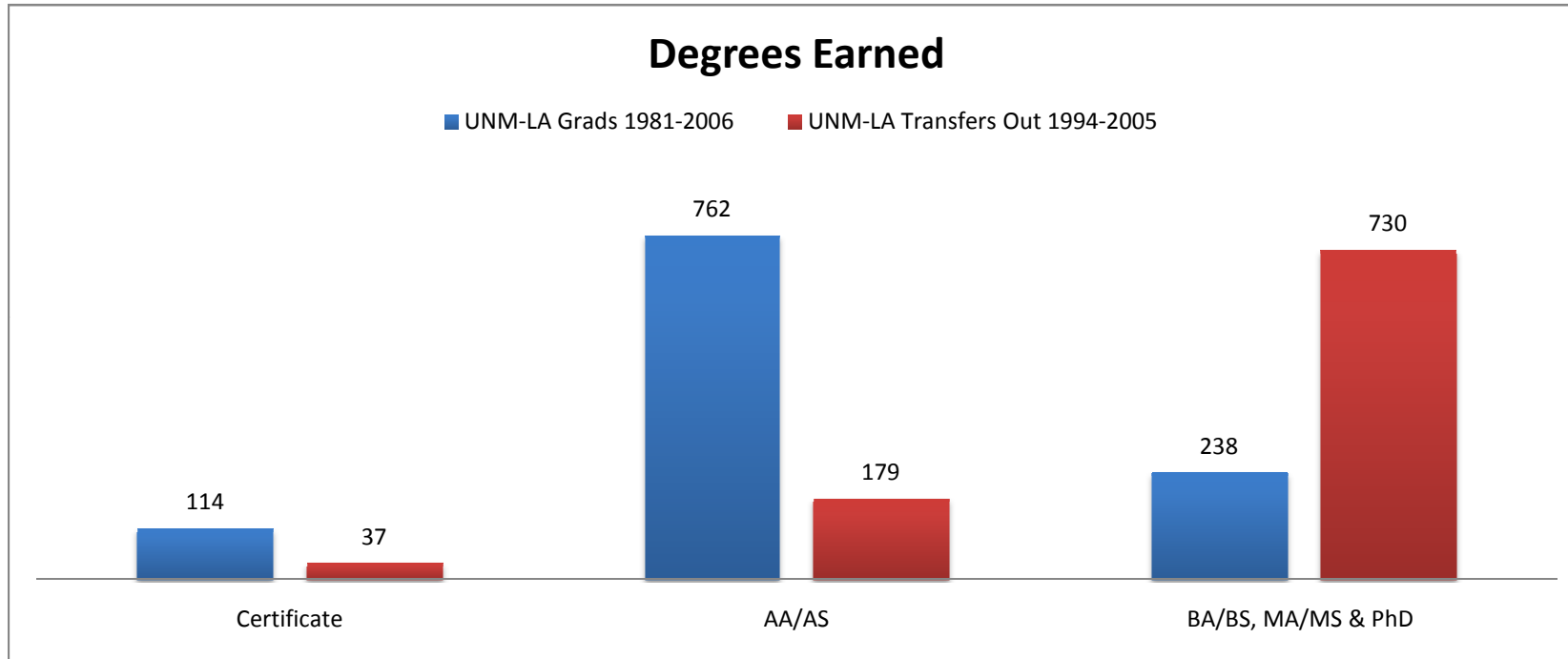

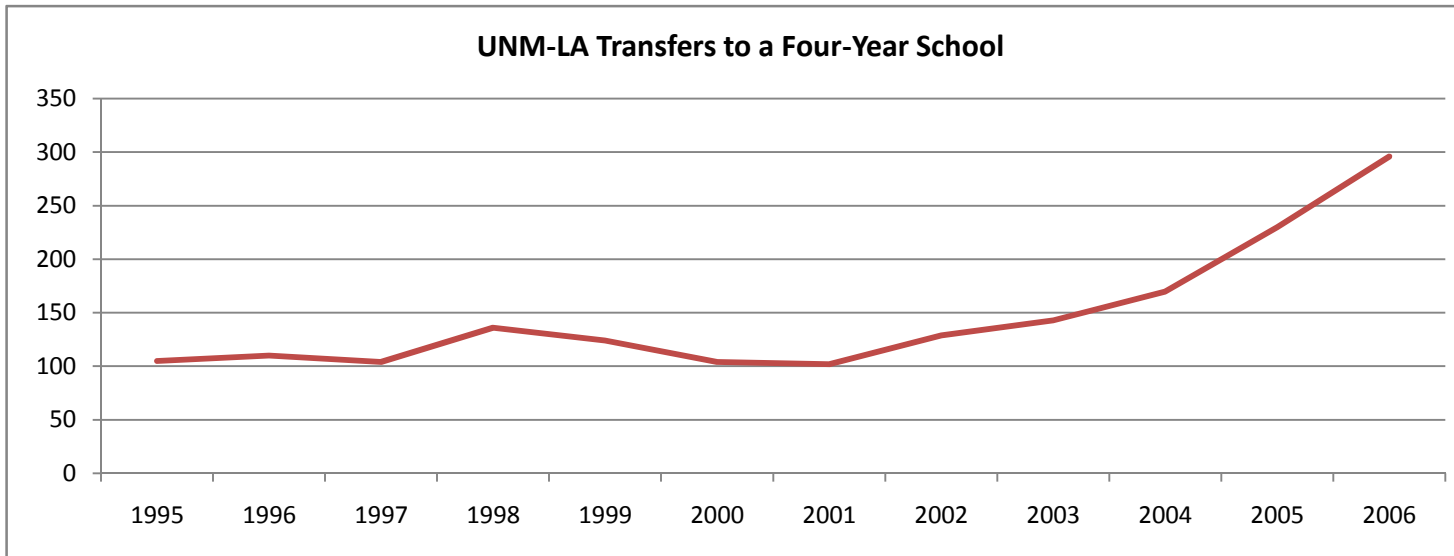
UNM-LA Students Who Transferred to a Four-Year Institution

According to the data provided by the NM HED Research Office, 1753 UNM-LA students transferred out to a Four-Year Institution since 1995. The busiest transfer year was 2006 with 296 transfers; the most popular destination is UNM Main with 1012 transfers, then NMSU with 246 transfers, although quite a few students 166 prefer to stay and attend UNM-LA EU. Since 1995 a total of 550 UNM-LA transfers earned a Bachelors degree; 147 of these earned a Masters, 16 earned a professional degree and 17 earned a PhD.

UNM-LA Students Who Transferred to a Four-Year Institution

The most popular majors for the 550 UNM-LA transfers who earned a Bachelor's degree were Business & Marketing, Computer & Info Services, Mechanical Engineering, Liberal Arts and Education. Those who also earned a masters degree preferred Chemical Engineering, Business & marketing, Education, Computer Sciences and Public Administration. Transfers who earned a Professional degree preferred Medicine, Pharmacology and Law; those pursuing a PhD preferred mostly Engineering, Biology and Health Sciences. This data clearly indicates that a great majority of students who begin their Higher Education career at UNM-LA, do not limit themselves to a two-year education, but pursue a wide range of Bachelor, Master, Professional and PhD degrees, thus serving as the biggest compliment to the great quality of UNM-LA's academic practices.

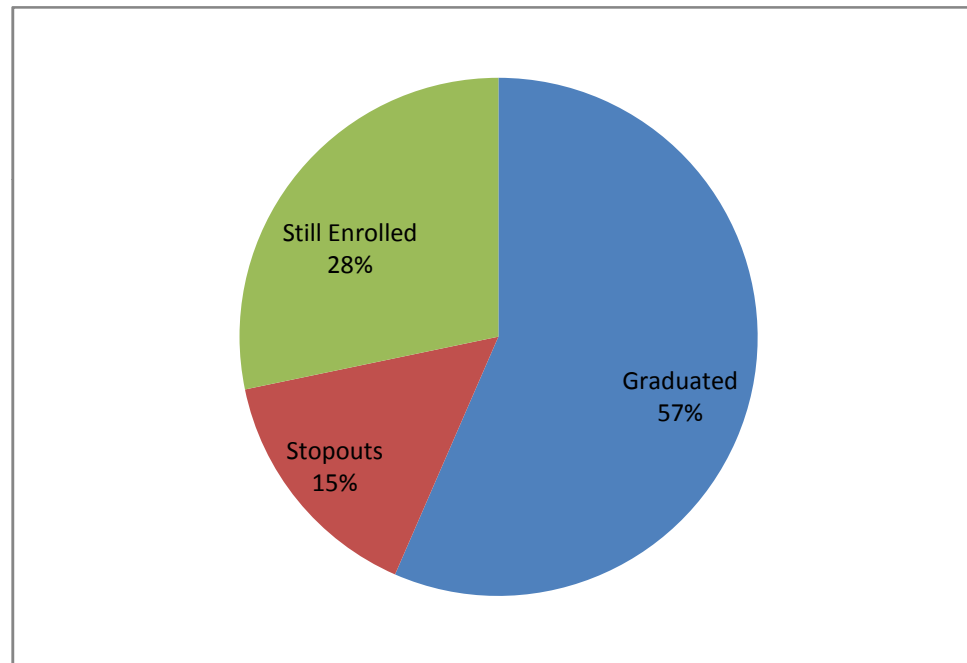
UNM-LA Transfers to UNM Main Spring 1998 - Fall 2008

According to the data provided by the UNM Main Institutional Research office, a total of 421 UNM-LA students transferred to UNM Main in the last 10 years. 57% of these graduated with a Bachelor degree with an average GPA of 3.4; 28% of transfers with an average GPA of 3.17 are still enrolled and 15% of students with average GPA of 2.95 did not graduate and are no longer enrolled. We assume that part of these students transferred to yet another school and part simply dropped out.

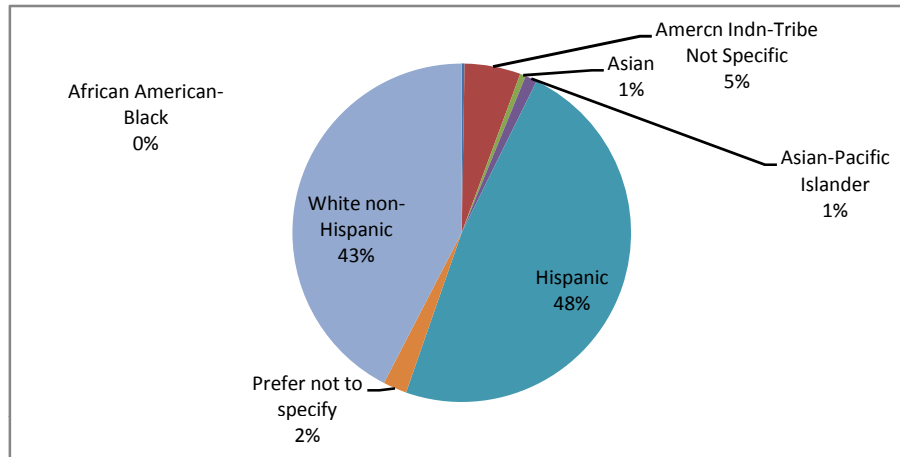

UNM-LA Transfers to UNM Main Spring 1998 - Fall 2008

Of the 421 transferred to UNM-Main, 356 had ethnicity and residence data on file. A closer look at these students shows that 48% of them were Hispanic and 42% were White, with 5% being American-Indian. The biggest group of our transfers comes from Bernalillo county (28%), followed by Los Alamos county (24%), Rio Arriba county (18%) and Santa Fe county (13%).

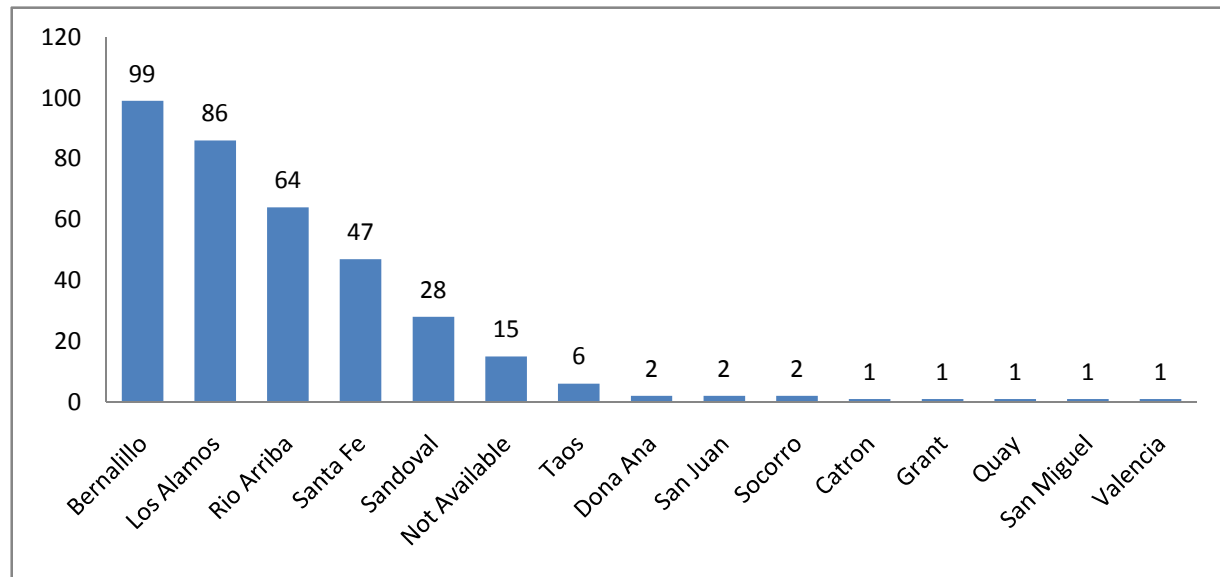

UNM-LA Transfers to UNM Main Spring 1998 - Fall 2008

Of the 421 transfers to UNM-Main, 383 had degree and major information on file. The most popular majors appear to be Business Admin, Engineering, Psychology, and Biology, with Undecideds making up the largest category. Bachelor of Arts is the most popular degree pursued by our Transfers, followed by Bachelor of Science, Bachelor of Business Admin, BS in Education, Bachelor of University studies and Master of Science.

UNM-LA Transfers to UNM Main Spring 1998 - Fall 2008

UNM-LA students who transferred to UNM Main in the last 10 years, show impressive academic performance. They have earned 47% As and 32% Bs in all of their coursework. A closer look shows that this kind of grade ratio holds true to their performance in Sci & Math courses as well, where they earned 41% As and 33% Bs, proving again that UNM-LA's reputation of providing students with strong Math & Science skills holds true and puts our transfers at an advantage at their destination school. Our students also do well in their English course work, earning 38% As and 39% Bs in the subject at UNM Main.
