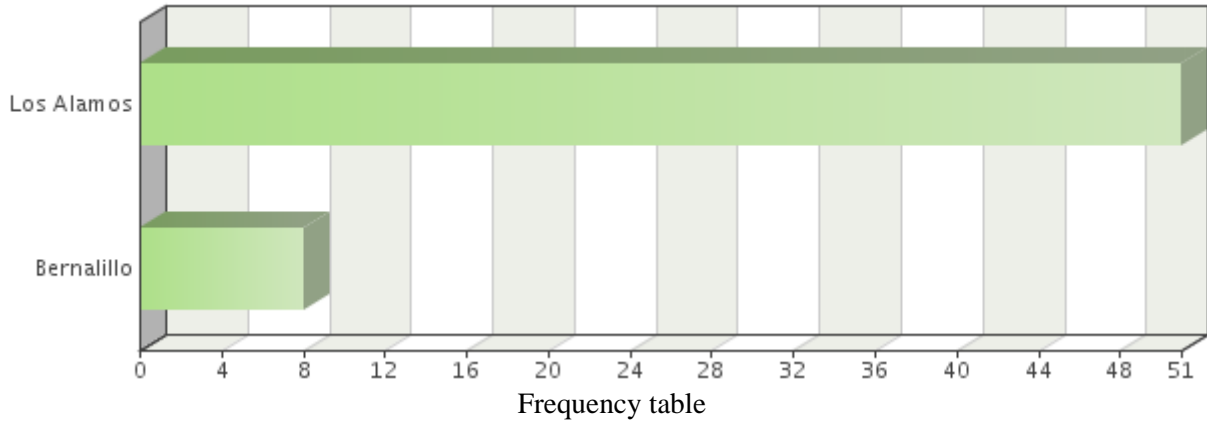

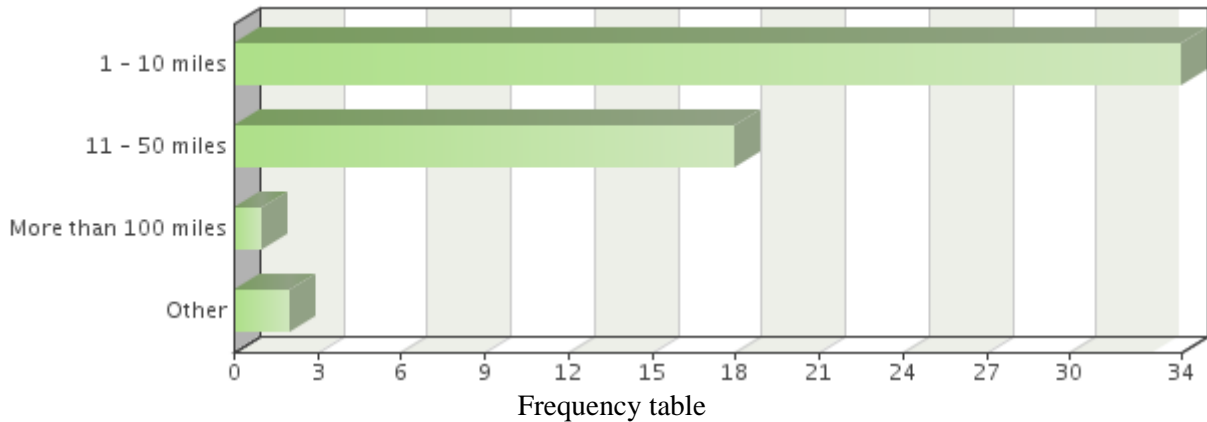
Where do you attend the majority of your classes?

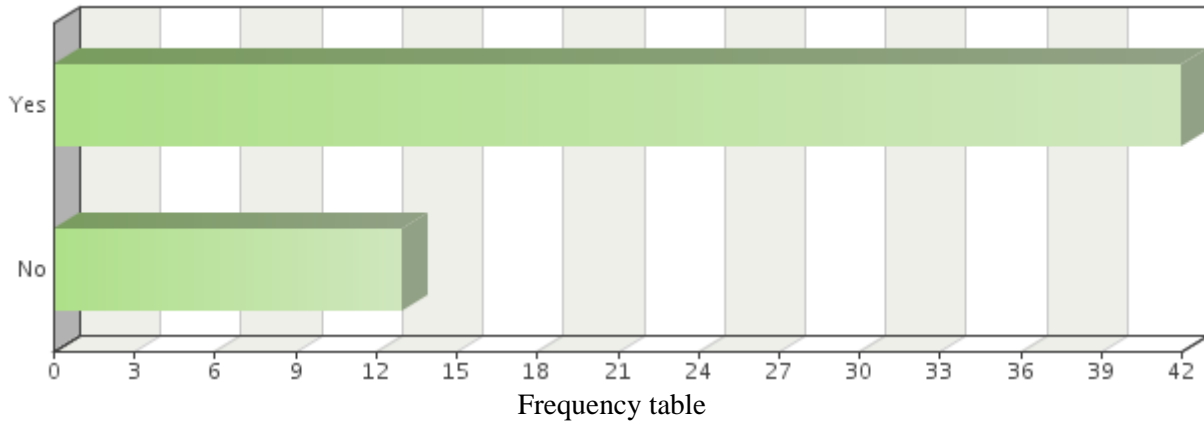
How many miles are you commuting one-way to attend classes at UNM-LA?

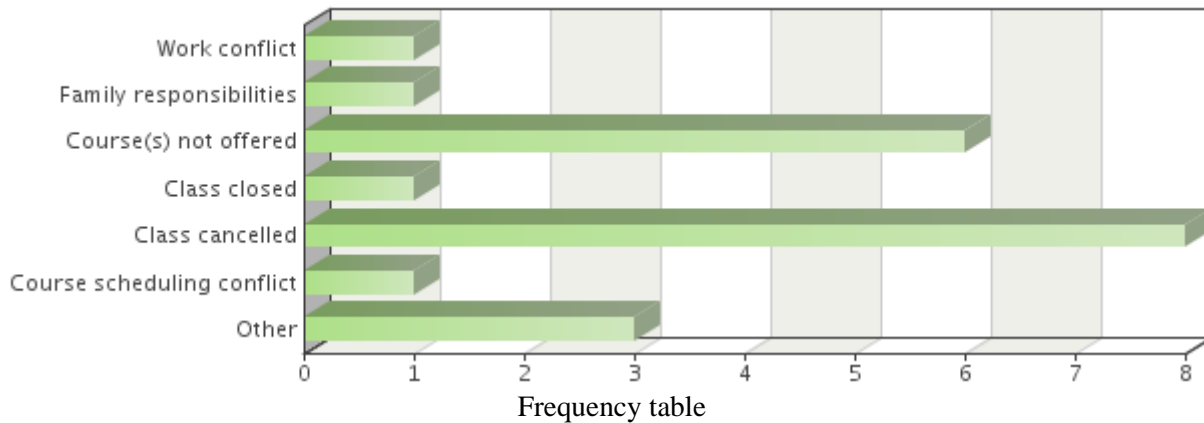
Were you able to enroll in all of the classes in which you were interested?

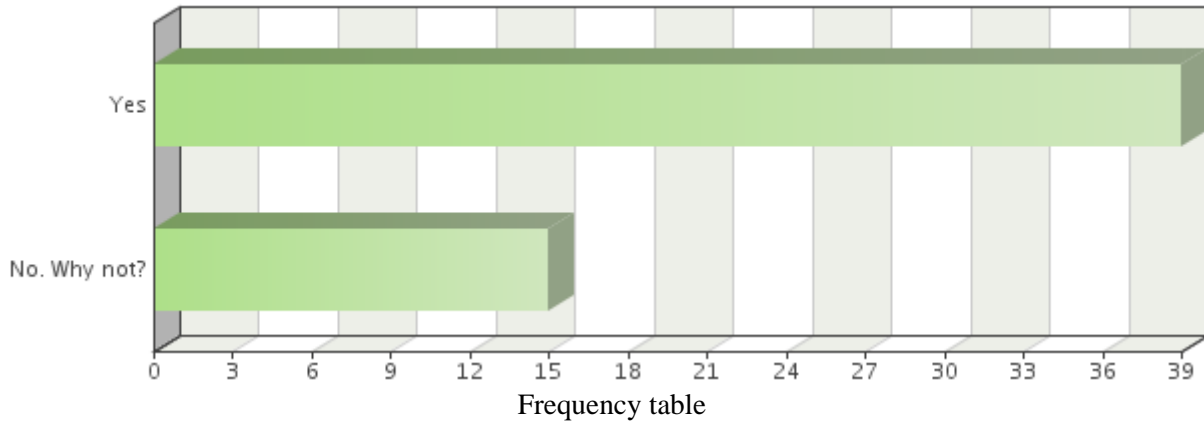
If you were not able to enroll in all of the classes in which you were interested, what was the reason

Did you seek academic advisement prior to the first day of classes?



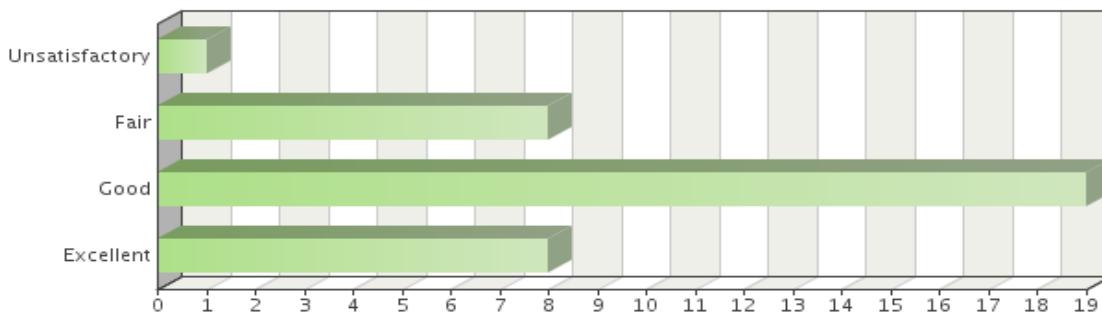

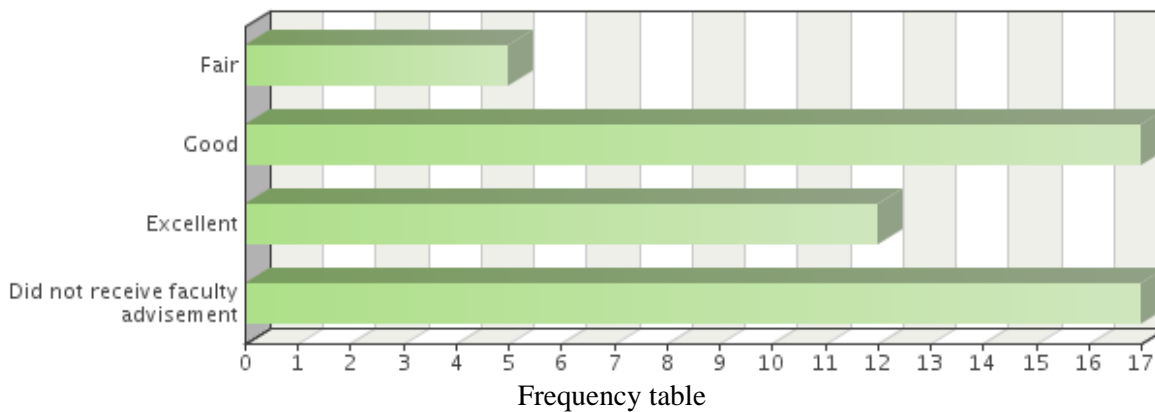

- All of my questions were answered clearly, they were very patient with me, and took the time to talk to me.
- My advisement went ok and the person was helpful, but I later found out on the first day of class that I had to be enrolled in two different classes that my advisor never told me about.
- The adviser did not tell me that the English class I enrolled in had a co-requisite, and I had to drop a class I was really interested in.
- They were able to give me good, accurate information for my needs in and out of school. It was great!
- She helped me by asking what I am interested in for my major and what score I got on my ACT for English and math and art. I told her to put me in 099 classes for review even though I did score high in math and English.
- Good, some stuck up people in Los Alamos.
- I thought that my advisor was very helpful. She really helped me understand what classes I needed to take.
- I am very close to graduating so I kept in touch with the advisor to ensure that the classes I needed were being offered. Which they were until 1 class got cancelled at the last minute! This through off my graduation date now because I was not able to find an open class available through another college.

How would you rate advisement received from a faculty member?



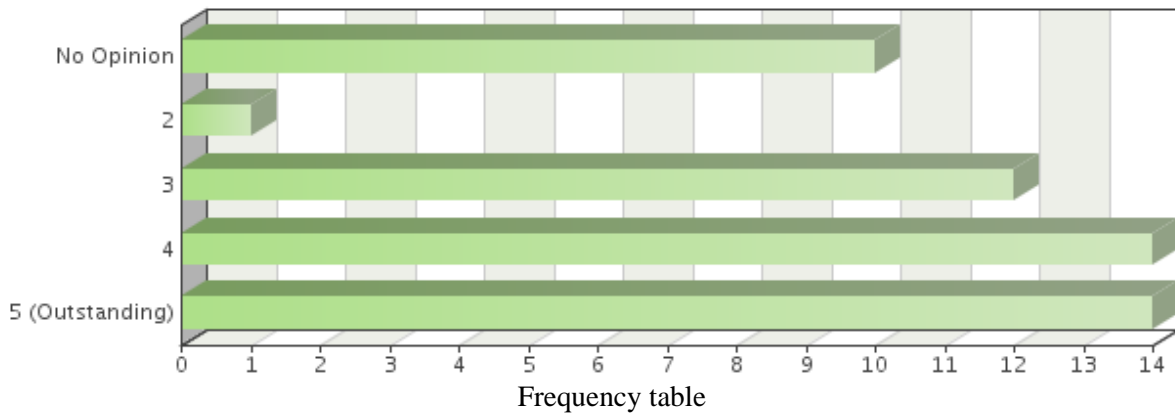

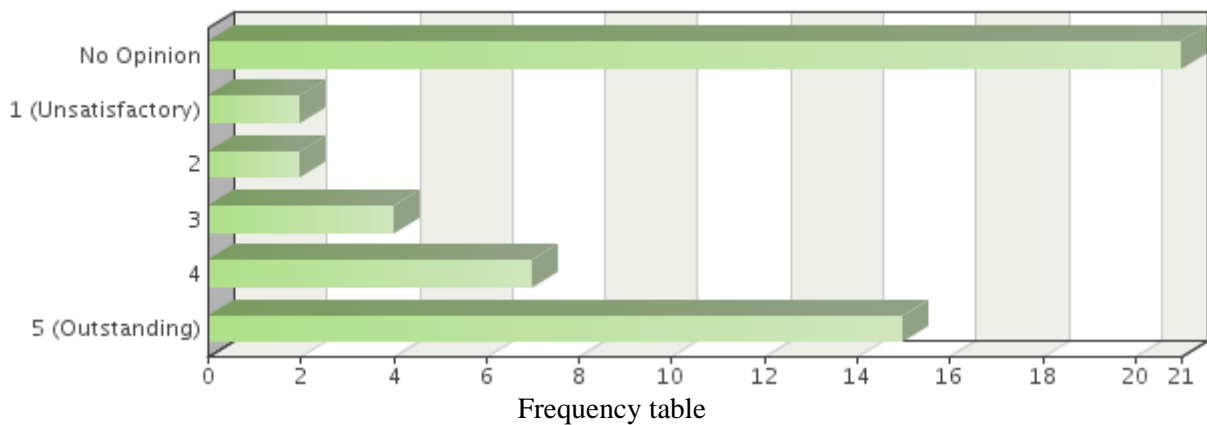
How would you rate the service you received at the UNM-Los Alamos Admissions office?

How would you rate the service you received at the UNM-Los Alamos Financial Aid/Scholarships office?

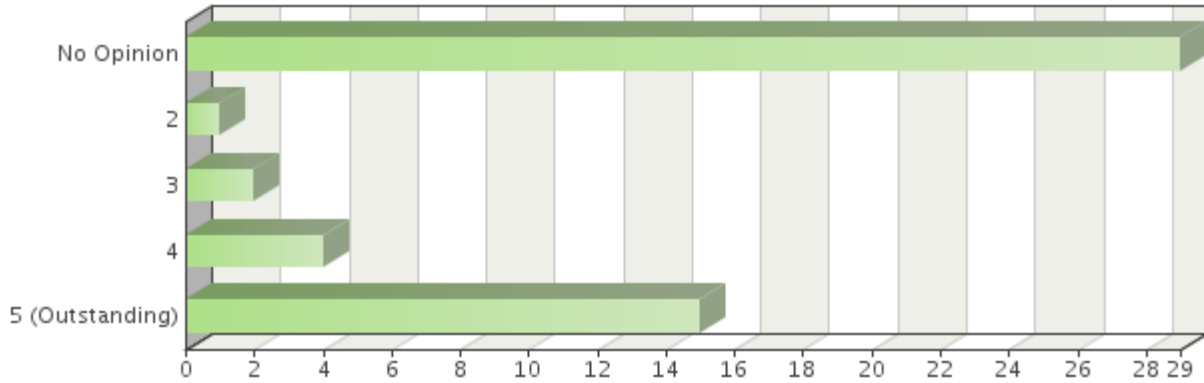

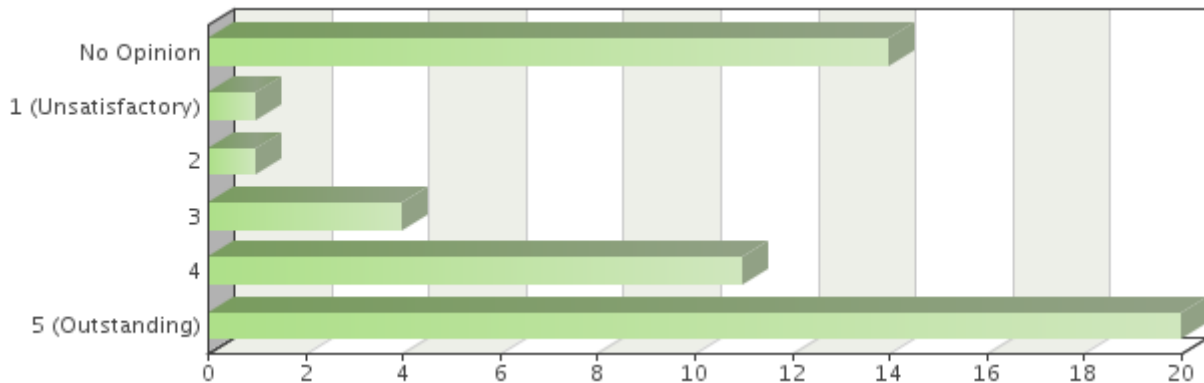
How would you rate the service you received at the UNM-Los Alamos Tutor Center?

How would you rate the service you received at the UNM-Los Alamos Library?

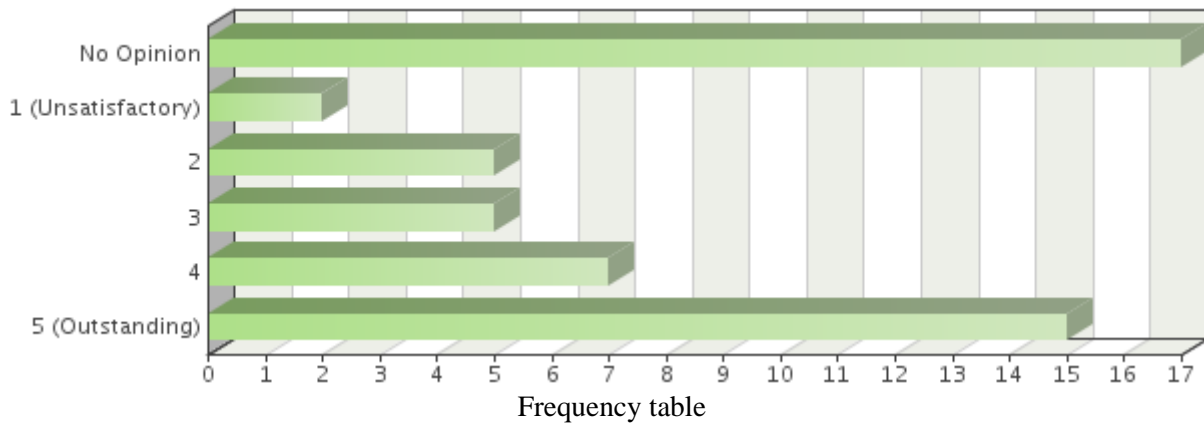

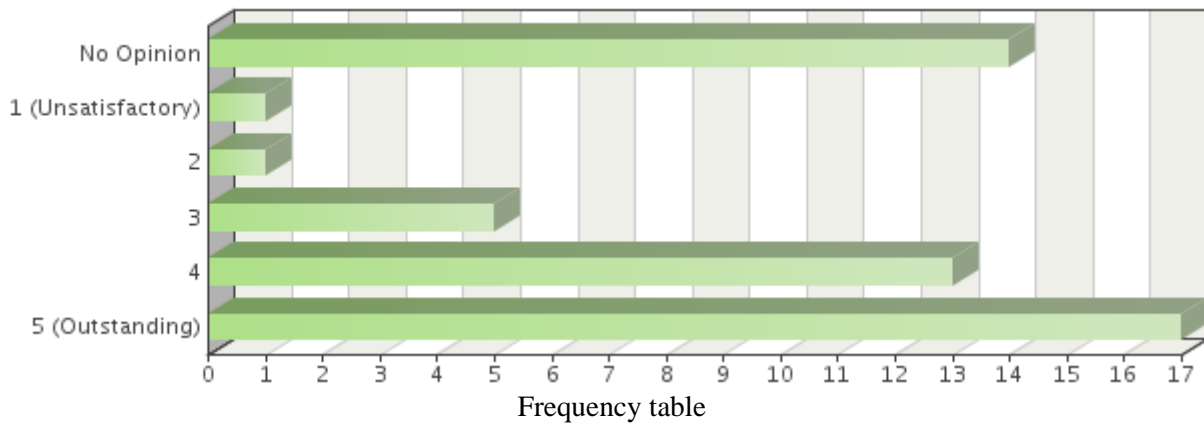
How would you rate the service you received at the UNM-Los Alamos Bookstore:

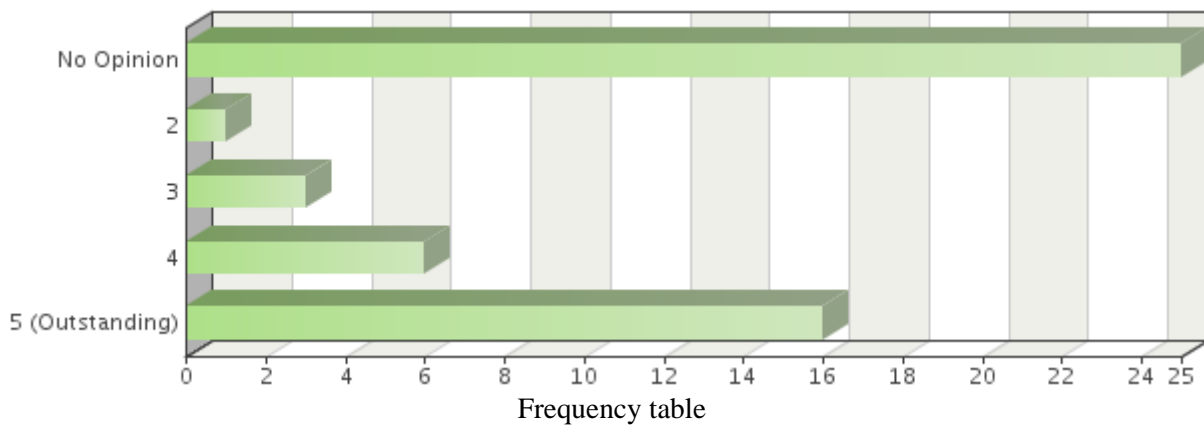
How would you rate the service you received at the UNM-Los Alamos Cashier's Office?

How would you rate the service you received at the Cafe?

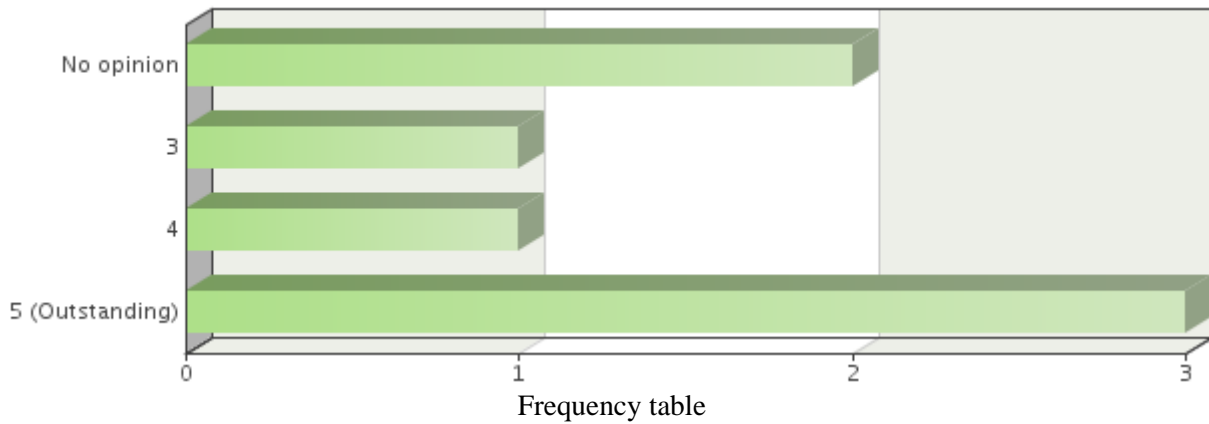

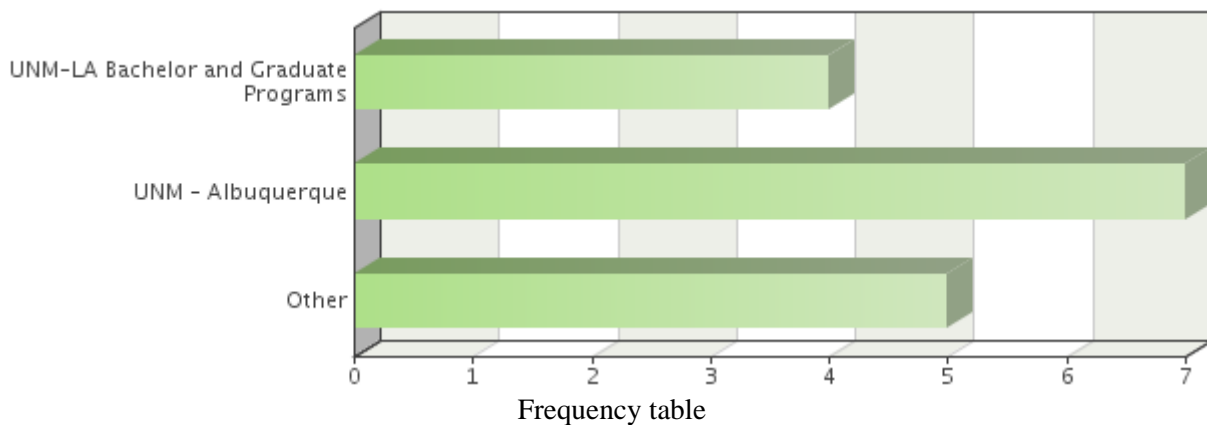

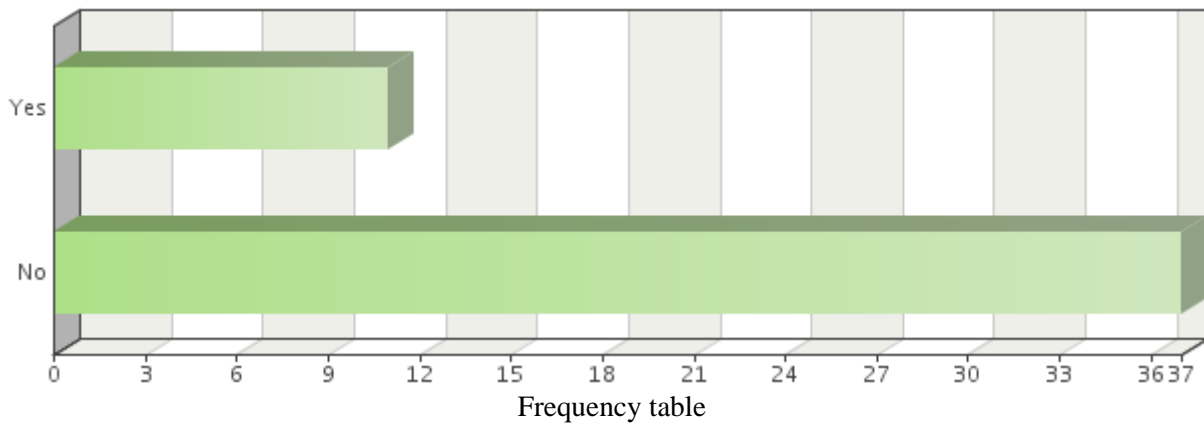

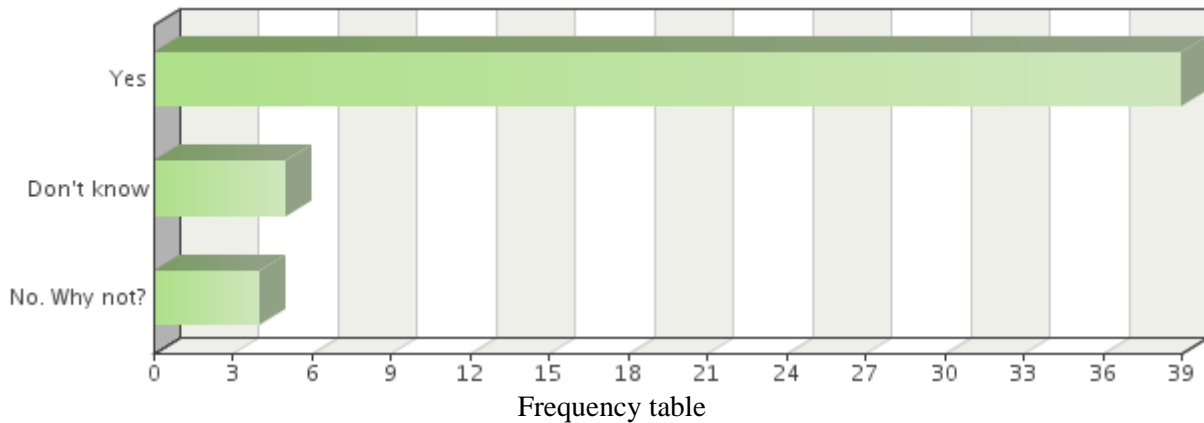
Are you the first person in your immediate family to attend college?

Do you plan to continue at UNM-Los Alamos next semester?



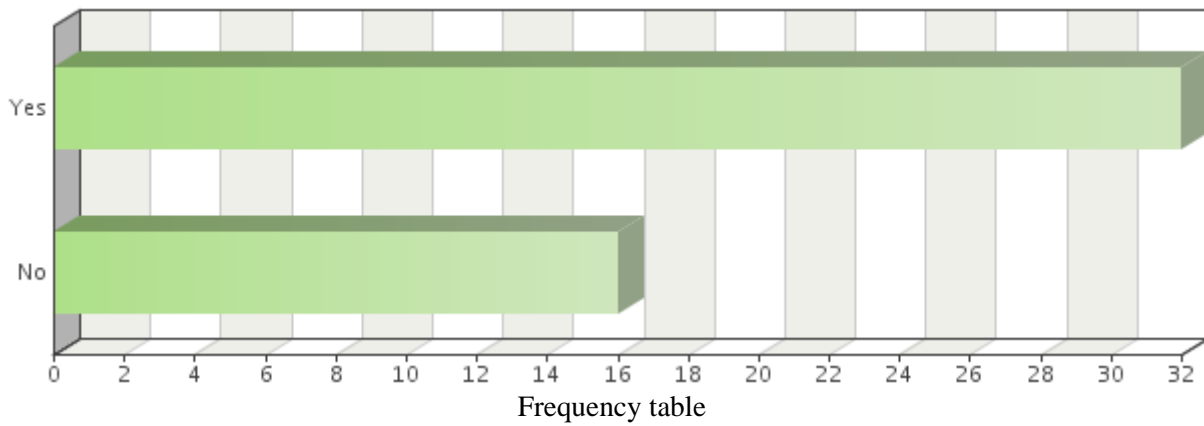

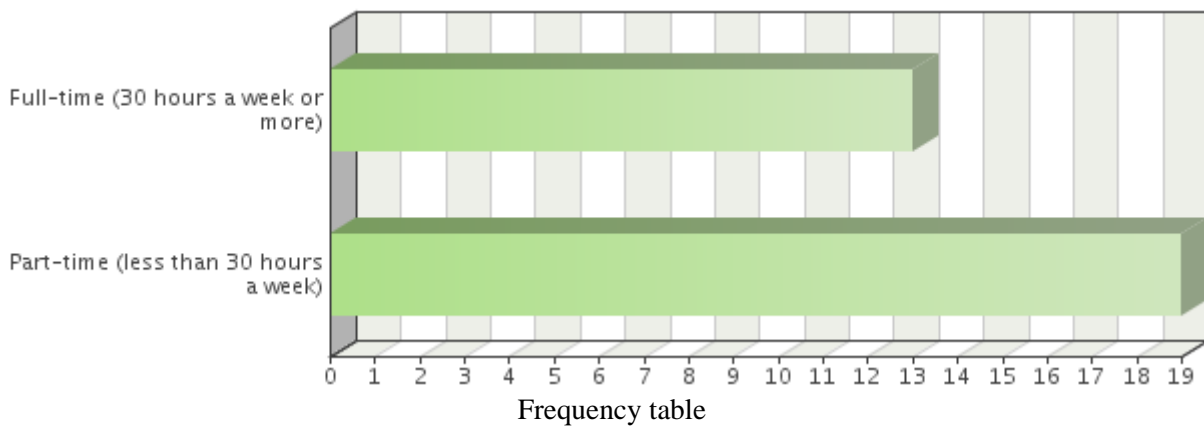
