Workforce Innovation in Regional Economic Development (WIRED) Community College Scholarship Program

The New Mexico WIRED Community College Scholarship Program provides funds to pay for tuition, books and other educational expenses as needed, for students enrolled in programs related to aerospace/aviation, green construction, microelectronics, optics, or renewable energy. UNM-Los Alamos has identified the following Career Pathway programs as eligible for this program: *Electro-Mechanical Technology, Environmental Science, Pre-Engineering, Web Technologies and Applied Technologies..*

Admission Requirements:

- ❑ 12 credit hours already completed toward Career Pathway (may include some but not all from developmental/remedial courses), OR (if entering freshman) 6 credits already completed of high school Career Technical Education program or equivalent
- ❑ FAFSA form submitted to the financial aid office at UNM-Los Alamos
- ❑ New Mexico residency; U.S. citizenship or permanent resident of the United States

Eligible Applicants Must:

- ❑ Enroll in a minimum of nine credit hours (preference may be given for full-time)
- ❑ Maintain a 2.5 GPA
- ❑ Progress to a timely completion of the program (funds expire fall 2010)
- ❑ Agree to meet the program's core requirements and follow specified course sequence
