1	ERB Retiree: If hired prior to 1986, have had a continued employee relationship and teach less than six (6) credit hours, the retiree will not be subject to FICA.
2	<p>Other ERB Institution: According to the New Mexico Educational Retirement Act, as amended through 1991, regular members of the Educational Retirement system are normally teachers, nurses, or administrators in any of the following local administrative units:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • State Institutions of Higher Education • Northern New Mexico Community College • Junior Colleges • Technical and Vocational Institutions • State Special Schools: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ School for the Deaf ◆ School for the Visually Handicapped ◆ New Mexico Boy's School ◆ Youth Diagnostic Center ◆ Los Lunas Hospital & Training School • State Agencies providing an educational program (i.e. Department of Corrections) • Public Schools in New Mexico
3	FTE: "Full-Time Equivalent" refers to the percentage of full-time worked. (For example, an employee working one-fourth of a full-time load is assumed to be working .25 FTE.)
4	.25 FTE: A three (3) hour course is considered .25 FTE for Main Campus, Continuing Education and the Graduate Centers. A three and three quarter (3.75) hour course is considered .25 FTE for Branch Campuses. Adjusted Credit Hours for oversized classes will cause the FTE to exceed .25 FTE.
